Preparation Checklist for Pesticide Treatment of Bed Bugs

<p>The successful elimination of bed bugs requires a coordinated effort between American Pest Services LLC and you, the client. Please use the below preparation checklist to ensure that we will be successful in your pesticide treatment and reduce the risk of re-infestation. All humans and pets will need to be out of the home during the treatment and for 6 hours following the treatment.</p>	
Prior to the Pesticide Treatment	
√	Item
	Strip bed linens and remove all clothing from drawers, suitcases and closets.
	Launder or dry clean all clothing and bed linens. For laundry, use hot, soapy water and dry on high heat (above 140° F). For dry clean items, ensure dry cleaner uses a process that exceeds 140° F.
	Place cleaned clothing and bed linens in sealed or tied plastic bags. Cleaned items should remain sealed in bags for the duration of the pesticide treatment.
	Vacuum all carpeted floors and use a crack and crevice tool along baseboards.
	Vacuum seams and surface area of all furniture including fold-out sofa beds.
	Move furniture far enough away from baseboards to allow technician to spray baseboards.
	Vacuum seams and surfaces of mattress and box spring, including underside of box spring.
	Remove and dispose of vacuum cleaner bag in sealed plastic bag and place in outside trash receptacle. For bag-less vacuums, empty canister and clean with hot soapy water.
	Clean pet bedding using a process that exceeds 140° F.
	Fish tanks must be covered and aerators shut off and covered during the treatment.
	We recommend that if you have heavily-infested and damaged furniture (mattresses, box springs, sofas, or chairs), that you consider discarding them prior to the pesticide treatment. Items to be discarded should be sealed in plastic before being removed from your home.
During the Pesticide Treatment	
	Humans and animals may not be in your home during the treatment. Arrangements should be made to have all occupants out of the home during the treatment.
	You may return to your home 6 hours after completion of the treatment. The technician will contact you when the treatment is complete.
After the Pesticide Treatment	
	The areas treated should be left alone as long as possible for 30 days after pesticide treatment.
	Should you notice any bed bugs 30 days after treatment, please contact us at 623-552-5034.
